Metro Express Project

Closure of Remy Ollier Avenue near its junction with Lees Avenue, Belle Rose

The public is hereby informed that pipe laying works pertaining to the Metro Express Project will be carried near the junction of Remy Ollier Avenue and Lees Avenue **as from Monday 10 February 2020 and for a period of 1 week.**

Accordingly, a stretch of Ollier Avenue will be closed to traffic near its junction with Lees Avenue. The following traffic diversion scheme will be put in place:

- Traffic along Remy Ollier Avenue coming from Port Louis-St Jean Road (A1) will be diverted through Lapeyrouse Avenue and Mallefile Avenue onto G. Ythier Avenue to join Remy Ollier Avenue.
- Traffic along Remy Ollier Avenue proceeding towards Port Louis-St Jean Road (A1) will be diverted through Victoria Avenue and Sir Vigil Naz Avenue onto G. Ythier Avenue to join Remy Ollier Avenue.
- Buses (Route 156) coming from Rose Hill along Port Louis-St Jean Road (A1) will be diverted through Boundary Road onto Pasteur Avenue to join Remy Ollier Avenue.
- Buses (Route 156) along Remy Ollier Avenue proceeding towards Port Louis-St Jean Road (A1) will be diverted through Murray Avenue, Boundary Road, Labourdonnais Street, Soopramanien Street onto Dr. Maurice Curé Street to join Port Louis-St Jean Road (A1)
- Related Bus Stops will be relocated.

The necessary traffic signs will be set up to inform and guide road users.

Drivers are strongly advised to exercise caution when approaching the work area and to drive within the prevailing speed limit.
