Metro Express Project

Activation of Traffic Lights for the new Light Railway junctions in Quatre Bornes and modification of traffic scheme at Belle Rose Avenue and Farquhar Avenue

The public is hereby informed that the traffic lights managing the intersections between the Light Railway System of the Metro Express Project and the road network between Rose Hill Central Station and the Municipal Council of Quatre Bornes will be activated and operational from **Wednesday 02**nd **June 2021**.

The said junctions are the following:

- Road-Rail intersection at Boundary Road (B75);
- Road-Rail intersection at Remy Ollier Avenue (B73);
- Road-Rail intersection at Sir Guy Forget/Belle Rose Avenue;
- Signalised Pedestrian crossing at Ythier Avenue near Mallefille Avenue intersection with G. Ythier Avenue;
- Signalised Pedestrian crossing at Victoria Avenue (B72) near intersection of Sir Virgil Naz and Victoria Avenue.

Additionally, the following new traffic schemes will be operational from the same day Wednesday 02nd June 2021:

- Belle Rose Avenue is converted into a two-way road between its junctions with d'Epinay Avenue and Victoria Avenue (B72), Quatre Bornes;
- Farquhar Avenue is converted into a one-way road from its junction with Sir Guy Forget Street to its junction Victoria Avenue, Quatre Bornes.

Traffic signs and Road Markings will be put in place to inform and guide road users.

Drivers are strongly advised to exercise caution when approaching these junctions and are asked to follow the prevailing road traffic rules and regulations.
