Duties:

- I. To carry out necessary measurements and calculations of the trade in accordance with technical specifications.
- II. To follow all safety guidelines when using specific tools and equipment of the trade.
- III. To use and maintain in good condition, all tools, equipment and accessories of the trade.
- IV. To undertake all types of maintenance (preventive and corrective) work related to their trade.
- V. To prepare estimates in regard to types and quantities of materials requires for specific trade.
- VI. To advise on the use and purchase of materials, tools and equipment, as may be required.
- VII. To ensure that –
 - a. All operations regarding the use of specific tools and equipment are carried out in compliance with safe practices;
 - b. All works undertaken are of good quality and as per instructions; and
 - c. Told and equipment are judiciously used and kept in good condition.
 - d. Return all tools to the maintenance store and secures in proper storage area.

- VIII. Regular check community spaces to identify issues with litter, mechanical failure or breakdowns.
- IX. Maintain the cleanliness of outside spaces, such as parking lots and sidewalks.
- X. Oversee the sprinkler system and trash containers on the company premises.
- XI. Conducting routine inspections of premises and equipment.
- XII. Overseeing contractors when professional repairs are necessary.
- XIII. Diagnosing mechanical issues and correcting them.
- XIV. Execute duties according to health and safety regulations.
- XV. Create a safe work environment for co-worker by completing all work assigned in a safe and professional manner.
- XVI. To be able to read and work from dimensional plans, drawings and sketches.
- XVII. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of output and results expected from Field Worker in the roles ascribed to them according to their posting.
