- Planned and schedule Preventive Maintenance (PM), Corrective Maintenance (CM) works under the Systems Group and as part of Engineering Work Plan, EWP;
- 2. Diagnose and resolve hardware and software issues in ticket vending machines, perform immediate repairs to minimize downtime and ensure machine functionality, replace defective components, such as printers, ticket card readers, coin and bank notes modules, Point Of Sales, POS and touch screens etc, conduct tests to ensure machines are operating correctly after repairs.
- 3. Prepare work instructions, weekly/monthly reports, Fault Investigation and Incident reports, Waiver of Nonconformity reports when and as required. Maintain detailed records of all maintenance and repair activities. Communicate effectively with management about machine status and potential improvements.
- 4. Attend to Signalling System, Communications System or Fare Equipment faults;
- 5. Raise work orders, perform, review and close the work orders;

- Follow-up of all faults/issues found during PM and raise CM work order;
- 7. Drive company vehicle, where required and possess a valid manual driving licence;
- 8. Perform installation, maintenance, and commissioning, of railway systems equipment.
- Fault-finding, repairing and adjustment of mechanical, electrical and electronics signalling equipment, including protected level crossings, Fare Systems, ETS and Communication & Monitoring Systems, C&M equipment.
- 10. Provide infrastructure support on Signalling, Fare Systems and Communication & Monitoring systems for planned and emergency maintenance activities.
- 11. Ensure all work is performed in accordance with Workplace Health and Safety (WH&S) requirements and legislative policies including work activities performed by subordinate employees.
- 12. Provide support to technicians during heavy rainfall, cyclonic conditions and confinement to plan recovery, transport and prepare roster.
- 13. Report on actual work performed against the scheduled work program and report any equipment performance and condition irregularities.
- 14. Progress the implementation and application of MEL work procedures, instructions and practices in pursuit of ensuring continuous quality improvement.
