- VI. assisting passengers during emergency;
- VII. providing assistance to any distress passengers;
- VIII. reporting all train faults to Control Operations effectively;
- IX. reporting any incident that will endanger and affect train service; and
- X. being alert and staying vigilant on security and safety of passengers.
- XI. To perform such other duties related to the main duties listed above or related to the roles ascribed to him.

Other Conditions

Incumbents will be -

- (a) <u>required to perform shift duties including Week Ends</u> <u>and Public Holidays</u>; and
- (b) subject to daily alcohol check on reporting for duty.
